Absheron & Gobustan: History & Fire

Savor breakfast before heading to **Gobustan National Park**, a UNESCO World Heritage site famous for ancient rock carvings and mud volcanoes. Continue to the **Ateshgah Fire Temple**, where natural gas has burned for centuries, and witness the eternal flame of **Yanar Dag** (Burning Mountain). Return to Baku.

DAY 04

Baku City Tour & Departure

After breakfast, check out and store your luggage. Enjoy a comprehensive city tour of Baku: wander the narrow streets of the **Old City (Icherisheher)**, visit the Maiden Tower and Palace of the Shirvanshahs, admire panoramic views from **Highland Park**, and stroll along **Baku Boulevard** on the Caspian Sea. Transfer to the airport for your departure flight.

Essential Travel Tips

Smart tips for a smoothAzerbaijan adventure

 Currency	Azerbaijani Manat (AZN). Credit cards are widely accepted in cities; carry cash for smaller purchases and local markets.
 Weather	Check the forecast and pack accordingly. Layers are often a good idea, especially between seasons.
 Dress Code	Azerbaijan is a Muslim-majority country. Dress modestly when visiting religious sites; casual wear is fine elsewhere.
 Baggage	Liquids in hand-carry must be under 100 ml per item. International airport rules apply.

Frequently Asked Questions

Everything you need to know before booking

- 1. What type of tour is this?** This is a private tour with a dedicated vehicle and English-speaking driver.
- 2. Which destinations will I visit?** Baku, Gabala, Gobustan National Park, Ateshgah Fire Temple, and Yanar Dag.
- 3. Are flights included in the package?** No, return flights are excluded. We can assist with flight bookings upon request.
- 4. What accommodation is provided?** 3 nights at Parkway Inn Hotel & Spa Baku (or similar 4-star hotel) on a bed-and-breakfast basis.
- 5. Is this tour suitable for families with children?** Yes. Child rates are available for ages 3–12 years, and infant rates apply for ages 0–2 years.
- 6. What meals are included?** Daily breakfast at the hotel is included. Lunch and dinner are at your own expense.
- 7. Are entrance fees to attractions covered?** No, entrance tickets to museums and attractions are excluded and must be paid locally.
- 8. What is the cancellation policy?**
 - 30+ days before departure: 50% of the holiday amount is non-refundable + full cancellation for non-refundable tickets.
 - Within 30 days: 100% of the total amount will be non-refundable.
- 9. Do I need a visa for Azerbaijan?** Yes, most nationalities require an Azerbaijan visa. Visa fees are excluded; please check requirements based on your nationality.
- 10. Will the guide speak English?** An English-speaking driver will accompany you throughout the tour.
- 11. Is travel insurance included?** No, travel insurance is not included but is highly recommended.
- 12. Can I extend my stay or customize the itinerary?** Extensions and customizations are possible upon request, subject to availability and additional charges.
