DAY 01

Arrival in Tbilisi: The Heart of Georgia

Upon arrival at Tbilisi International Airport (TBS), you will be met by our representative and transferred to your hotel. Check in, relax, and settle into your room. The rest of the day is free for you to rest or explore the local area at your leisure.

DAY 02

Majestic Mountains of Gudauri & Kazbegi

After breakfast, embark on a full-day mountain excursion. Stop at the turquoise **Jinvali Water Reservoir**, visit the 17th-century **Ananuri Fortress**, and drive along the scenic Georgian Military Highway. Arrive in Kazbegi and take a 4x4 vehicle up to the iconic **Gergeti Trinity Church**, perched high on a hill with magnificent views of Mount Kazbeg.

- **Meals:** Breakfast

DAY 03

The Wine Region of Kakheti

After breakfast, journey to the **Kakheti region**, Georgia's famous wine country. Explore **Sighnaghi**, the "City of Love," with its charming cobblestone streets and stunning views of the Alazani Valley. Visit a local winery to learn about the unique Georgian qvevri winemaking method and enjoy a tasting session. Discover the historical **Bodbe Monastery**, home to the remains of St. Nino.

DAY 04

Tbilisi City Tour & Departure

After breakfast and check-out, enjoy a captivating city tour of Tbilisi. Stroll through the narrow streets of the **Old Town**, visit the **Holy Trinity Cathedral** and **Metekhi Church**, take the cable car to **Narikala Fortress** for panoramic views, and explore the sulfur bath area and charming **Shardeni Street**. Depending on your flight schedule, you will be transferred to Tbilisi International Airport (TBS) for your return flight.

Essential Travel Tips

Smart tips for a smooth Georgia Adventure

 Currency	Georgian Lari (GEL). Credit cards are widely accepted in cities; carry cash for smaller purchases, markets, and rural areas.
 Weather	Four distinct seasons. Mountainous regions are much cooler; pack layers and a light jacket even in summer.
 Dress Code	Casual and comfortable; modest clothing for churches and monasteries (covered shoulders and knees).
 Baggage	Liquids in hand-carry must be under 100 ml per item. International airport rules apply. Power sockets are type C and F (220V / 50Hz).

Frequently Asked Questions

Everything you need to know before booking

- 1. What type of tour is this?** This is a private tour with a dedicated vehicle and professional English-speaking guide.
- 2. Which destinations will I visit?** Tbilisi, Gudauri, Kazbegi, Sighnaghi, and the Kakheti wine region.
- 3. Are flights included in the package?** Yes, return economy class air tickets with baggage allowance are included.
- 4. What accommodation is provided?** 3 nights at Astoria Hotel Tbilisi (or similar 4-star hotel) on a bed-and-breakfast basis.
- 5. Is this tour suitable for families with children?** Yes. Child rates are available for ages 3–12 years, and infant rates apply for ages 0–2 years.
- 6. What meals are included?** Daily breakfast at the hotel is included. Lunch and dinner are at your own expense unless specified.
- 7. Are entrance fees to attractions covered?** No, entrance tickets are excluded and must be paid locally.
- 8. What is the cancellation policy?**
 - 30+ days before departure: 50% of the holiday amount is non-refundable + full cancellation for non-refundable tickets.
 - Within 30 days: 100% of the total amount will be non-refundable.
- 9. Do I need a visa for Georgia?** Yes, most nationalities require a Georgia tourist visa. Visa fees are excluded; it is your responsibility to obtain the necessary visa.
- 10. Will the guide speak English?** Yes, a professional English-speaking guide will accompany you on all tours.
- 11. Is travel insurance included?** No, travel insurance is not included but is highly recommended.
- 12. Can I extend my stay or customize the itinerary?** Extensions and customizations are possible upon request, subject to availability and additional charges.
- 13. How do I book this package?** Contact us with your preferred dates, number of travelers, and room configuration. We will check availability and provide payment instructions to confirm your booking.

14. What should I pack? Layered clothing, comfortable walking shoes, a light waterproof jacket, sunscreen, and a reusable water bottle.

15. Are there any physical fitness requirements? A moderate fitness level is recommended. The itinerary involves walking on cobblestones, some uphill paths, and high-altitude areas in Kazbegi.
